GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

Submission Method:

- Acceptance Notification by the committee: **August 30, 2026**



Presentation type:

- Oral presentation: Each presenter will have 10 minutes, including time for questions.
- Poster: Each poster should be 70 cm (width) x 100 cm (height) mounted vertically

Research Fields:

- Basic Sciences
- Health Sciences
- Engineering
- Social Sciences and Humanities

Please note:

- Multiple abstract submissions per person will not be accepted.
- All abstracts will be submitted with the understanding that ethical guidelines for research have been adhered to.
- The Conference Committee will review all abstracts and has the right to reject any abstracts that do not meet the conference criteria. Due to time constraints during the conference, it may not be possible to include all proposals for oral presentations in the program. Some authors of abstracts not included for oral presentations will be offered the opportunity to present their work in poster format.
- Due to time constraints in the conference program, the Conference Program Committee may need to adjust the length of oral presentations. If such adjustments are necessary, all presenters will be notified promptly.



- All authors who have submitted abstracts will receive notification of the Committee's decisions by **August 30, 2026**.
- By submitting your abstract, you consent to its review and publication in the conference materials.
- The committee reserves the right to edit abstracts for the conference program to ensure proper formatting, space requirements, and readability.
- If you wish to withdraw your abstract, please contact the Conference Organizers via email at (aparc@suez.edu.eg) before **August 29, 2026**. After this date, the Conference Organizers will assume that all other authors or presenters have been informed of the withdrawal.

Abstract Guidelines

- Titles: 13pt, Bold, Times New Roman
- Authors: 12pt, Times New Roman
- Affiliations: 8pt, Times New Roman, Bold
- Abstracts should include the following sections:
 - Background and aims
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- Abstracts (a maximum of 250 words, upper and lower case, 12pt, Bold)
- Keywords (3-5 keywords, 10pt, Italic, Bold)
- Check spelling and grammar.

Artificial Intelligence in Dentistry: Current Clinical Trends and Future Perspectives

ABSTRACT: The term “artificial intelligence” (AI) refers to the idea of building machines that can perform tasks that are normally performed by humans. The field of AI has experienced spectacular development and growth over the past two decades which led to the expansion of AI applications into areas that were previously thought to be reserved for human experts. When applied to medicine and dentistry, AI has tremendous potential to improve patient care and revolutionize the health care field. In dentistry, AI is being investigated for a variety of purposes, specifically identification of normal and abnormal structures, diagnosis of diseases and prediction of treatment outcomes. This presentation describes some current and future applications of AI in dentistry.

Poster Guidelines

- Posters will be arranged by topic. Each poster display will measure 70 x 100 cm and should be mounted vertically.
- The poster should include the following sections: abstract, introduction, methodology, results, discussion with relevant illustrations (e.g., figures, tables) and conclusions and recommendations.
- At the top of each poster, include a label with the following information: title, authors, and author affiliations. Do not use logos or advertising material on the poster. The official language for the Poster Session will be English, as well as Arabic in the social sciences and humanities sector.
- The first author of the poster is responsible for proper assembly, mounting, and display of the poster.
- Ensure that illustrations and text are legible from a distance of at least one and a half meters. The poster should be understandable without oral explanation. Use heavily drawn lines for all elements.

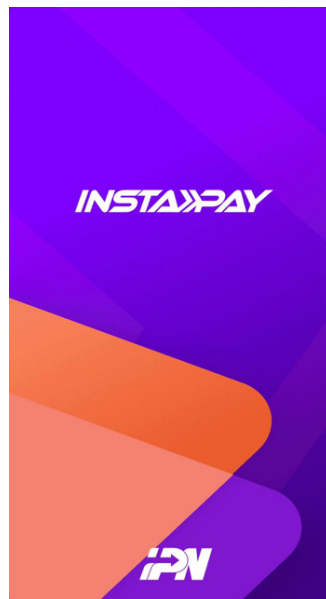
